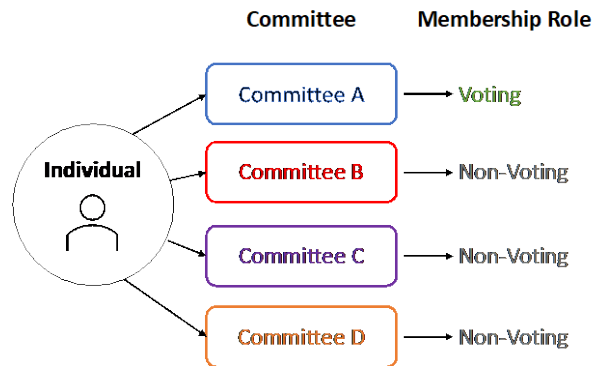


Overview

Participate with an Individual Membership

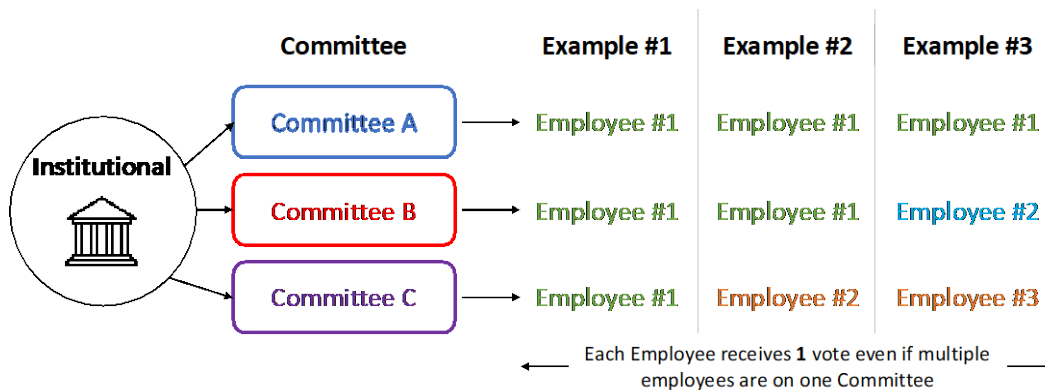
ICOM individual members may join up to four ICs: one as a voting member and three as a non-voting member.



Participate with an Institutional Membership

Institutions may designate up to three of its employees, called Designated Representatives, to represent them as voting members on ICs. One employee will act as the Point of Contact for the institution. Institutions have multiple options for designating employees as representatives as seen in the below examples. Each employee receives one vote even if multiple employees are on one Committee.

Institutional employees interested in an IC as a non-voting member should contact the IC’s chair.



Get Started

Step 1: Navigate to the [online ICOM Membership Application form](#) or request a mail-in application form by emailing chair.drmc@icom.museum.

Step 2: Select Membership Type: Select Membership type: **Individual** or **Institutional**.



Individual Membership

ICOM individual members may join up to four International Committees: **one as a voting member** and **three as a non-voting member**.

Institutional Membership

Institutions can designate **up to three of its employees**, called **Designated Representatives**, to represent them on International Committees. Institutions must designate **one Point of Contact** to manage the Designated Representatives. Each Employee receives **one vote** even if multiple employees are on one Committee.

Use the dropdowns to select **DRM – Disaster Resilience Museums** or another International Committee.

Every Employee has one vote even if multiple employees are on one Committee.
